A.

1. Club Persia has planned to celebrate the Persian New year (beginning of spring) in University of Oregon. In this event, Club Persia will introduce Iranian culture and lifestyle in an interactive and fun way during the celebration. In this event we will have guest speakers, Persian music and dance, slide show and presentations, and questions and answers at the end.
 - A. There will be Iranian food, sweets, and tea for our guests which would cost \$800/200 guests. Food will be provided by Caspian Restaurant.
 - B. To advertise our event we are going to provide Persian tea hour in other existing clubs on campus. There will be tea and desserts to encourage students to participate and hear about all we have to offer in Club Persia and what our next event would be. There will be two tea parties and each would cost \$100/50 guests.
 - C. There will be \$100 cost for printing posters and signs.

Total Cost: \$1100 for 3 events.

2. The main cost is for providing food which has deep roots in Iranian culture. Iranians cook very sophisticated foods which are passed from generation to generation for thousands of years. Without being able to provide food there is less encouragement for busy students to participate in an event that is not really related to their culture.
3. There will be tickets for sale to non-student guests. Each ticket would be \$8 for adults and \$4 for kids.
4. We believe that by showing the real Iran and raising the awareness of people about Iranian culture, we would be able to have a huge impact on the future relationship between the two countries. Persian and American cultures have a lot in common that need to be emphasized in order to solve the problems which are based on the small differences.
